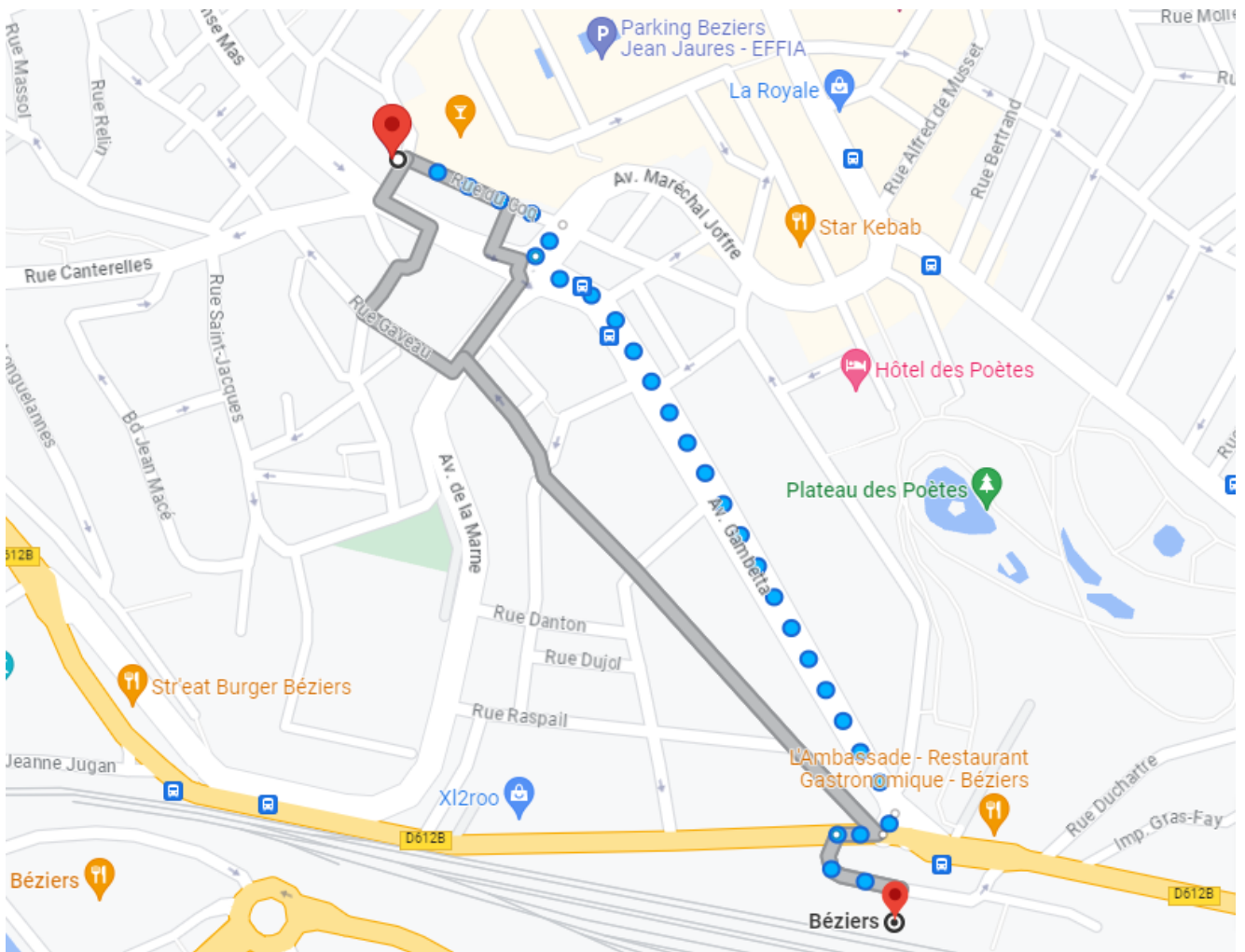

Getting to the accommodations

If you arrive by train or shuttle from the airport at Béziers train station, it will take you approximately 8 minutes to walk the 650 meters to reach the apartments. Using the city buses for less than one euro, take bus number 18 and get off at GARIBALDI.





If you arrive by plane at Béziers Cap d'Agde Airport, you can take the shuttle to Béziers train station, which costs 1.60 €. From there, you can then take bus number 18 for 1.00 €. Alternatively, you have the option to take a taxi, which typically costs between 30 € and 40 €.

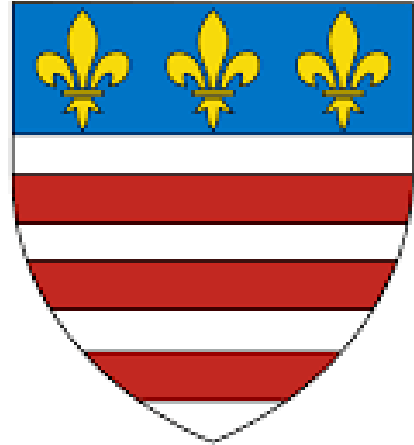
Arrival

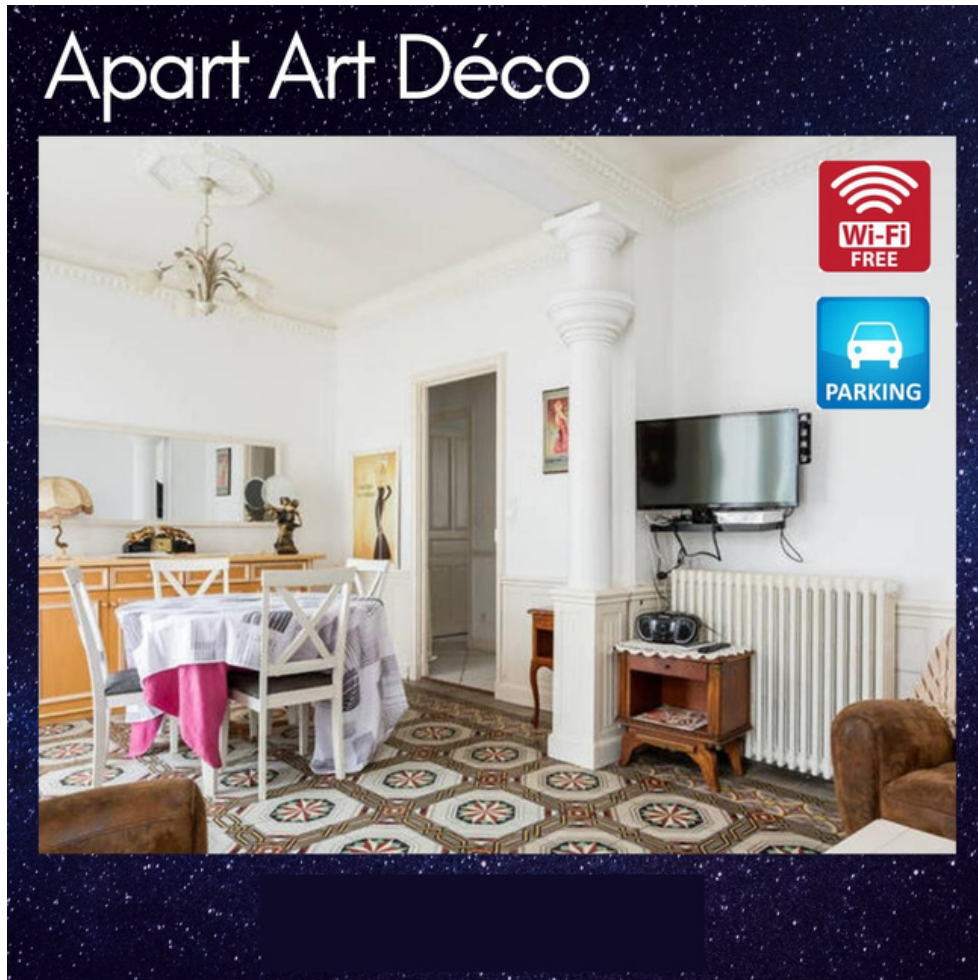

BUS

Getting around by bus in our area
For access to numerous tourist sites, the 17 municipalities of the Agglomération are served by beeMob, which offers urban and peri-urban lines with over 600 stops, including more than 150 accessible ones. The single ticket (1 €/journey), available only on the bus, is valid on the entire beeMob network.

*Here are some places
to visit in Béziers:*

Cathédrale Saint-Nazaire

The cathedral is a Gothic-style church dating back to the 13th century. It offers breathtaking views of the surrounding vineyards and the foothills of the Massif Central.



Canal du midi

To the west of Béziers, the canal that connects Sète on the Mediterranean to Toulouse and ultimately the Atlantic via the Garonne River passes through a series of charming ancient villages. Start your journey westward with the seven locks of Fonseranes, where you can rent bikes or boats for a unique experience.



Roquebrun

A picturesque village in the Orb Valley, located about 20 km north of Béziers, which seems to cling to the cliff above the river. Known for its microclimate, vineyards, and Mediterranean garden, it is also a great place to rent canoes or swim in the river.





Unlike some popular city destinations in Europe, Béziers doesn't attract massive crowds of foreign tourists, and it offers a pleasant living experience even on a small budget. This small town, with its magnificent cathedral and fabulous Canal du Midi, has a peaceful charm, allowing you to leisurely stroll through its historic streets.

Béziers is surrounded by some of the most beautiful countryside in southern France and is just a few kilometers away from the Mediterranean coast, making it an ideal base for a vacation in the south of France. The city is also easily accessible from Carcassonne, Sète, Agde, and Narbonne. The Béziers - Cap d'Agde Airport has a typical Mediterranean climate with hot and dry summers, a beautiful autumn, and short winters. It is the warmest region in France, with summer temperatures often exceeding 30°C.

As the oldest city in Occitania, older even than Marseille, Béziers holds the label of "city of art and history." Its arenas, bridges, and its commanding position overlooking the banks of the Orb and the Canal du Midi make it a historic Occitan magnet. Built by the Greeks in the 7th century BC, according to archaeological excavations, it could be the oldest city in France, predating Marseille.

Its feria, legendary bullfighter Sébastien Castella, and viticulture make it a place of culture and gastronomic tradition. Equally renowned, the Society of Fine Arts of the city, founded by the painter Gustave Fayet, has been hosting contemporary art exhibitions since 1901, featuring works by Paul Cézanne, Vincent Van Gogh, and Paul Gauguin.

Béziers



In Occitania and throughout the Languedoc region, Béziers is known for two things in particular: wine and the Féria. Undoubtedly, the best time to visit this city, perched on a rocky spur overlooking the plain of the Hérault, is in August during the four days of the Féria. Béziers is also perfectly situated for excursions into the Haut Languedoc, a wild, mountainous, and picturesque region with its stone villages and cascading mountain streams. Time is rarely wasted here, and strolling through the old town, bordered on three sides by the River Orb and a canal, is extremely pleasant.

Visiting the Region - Useful Information

Béziers, the oldest city in France, became a Roman colony in 36 BC and formed an important stop on the Via Domitia, the chariot road that crossed the entire Languedoc on the way from Rome to Cadiz in southern Spain, becoming a major trade route.

Indeed, trade has been the cornerstone of Béziers for centuries, especially in the wine industry. In fact, the amphora, a container for transporting wine in the ship's hold, was invented by the city's winemakers.

In the 13th century, the city witnessed one of the worst massacres in the region - 20,000 people were put to death during the crusade against the Cathars. Cathars, many of whom had found refuge in Béziers, were indiscriminately massacred, both Cathars and Catholics, on the orders of a papal legate who commanded the army to "Kill them all, God will recognize His own."
